COURSE

- » Vast and stunning desert landscape & iconic locations
- » 4-7 checkpoints daily
- » 8-11 hours per day competition

2 VEHICLE CLASSES

4x4	4-wheel drive vehicles with two-speed transfer case (low range) Pickup trucks & SUVs with 4WD including Toyota Tacoma, 4Runner, Chevy Colorado, GMC Canyon, Land Rover Range Rover, Jeep Wrangler, etc.
Crossover	Unibody construction with all-wheel drive (no low range) Subaru Forrester/Outback, Mitsubishi Outlander, Toyota RAV4, Range Rover Evoque, Jeep Cherokee, etc.

THE ROUGH

- » Driving and navigating over 2,000 kilometers in 7 days.
- » No GPS, cell phones, binoculars. This is old school!
- » Dirt, dirt, and more dirt - covering legal dirt roads, double tracks, trails, and sand dunes.
- » No outside assistance. However, teams can help each other.
- » Camping in Base Camp means tent, sleeping pad, sleeping bag. Self camping on one marathon leg.
- » Fuel management. Only one fueling per day translates to managing your fuel economy.

THE REFINED

- » Start & Finish Hotels - Registration includes start and finish hotels.
- » Basecamp Camping = Traveling support village complete with showers, medical staff, mechanics, event staff, and officials.
- » Basecamp Dining = By Michelin Star & celebrity chef, Drew Deckman
- » Closing Black Tie Gala - Pack your best black tie garb, as we will celebrate in grand style - outdoors and under the stars along the shores of the Pacific Ocean. The historic Del Mar Racetrack's Paddock Green will be the site of this "no miss" event.





PRICE INCLUDES

- » 10-day event | 7 days of competition
